Content : Regarding Article 10 of the Regulations Governing International Students Undertaking Studies in Taiwan stipulations regarding international students who have legitimate resident status or who are undertaking a program approved on a case by case basis by the Ministry of Education: if the degree programs are offered by collaborating domestic and foreign universities and have been approved on a case by case basis by the Ministry of Education, and such universities have specific administrative mechanisms to verify that such programs are in this category, then the restriction that stipulates that international students may not undertake any recurrent or continuing education bachelor's degree program or in-service master's degree program offered by any university or college in Taiwan, or any other program which is only taught in the evenings or during vacations does not apply.
