Content: Basis:

Subparagraph 2, Article 4 of the Act for the Recruitment and Employment of Foreign Professionals

Notice:

Foreign special professionals possessing special expertise in sports must meet one of the following criteria:

- The person has served as an athlete in a national team, has outstanding skills and been able to help improve the sporting competitiveness of the ROC, and has achieved one of the following accomplishments:
- finishing in the top eight in an official sport at the Olympic (1)Games.
- (2) finishing in the top three in an official sport at the Asian Games.
- finishing in the top three in an official sport at the World Games. (3)
- (4)finishing in the top three in an official sport at the Universiade.
- (5)finishing in the top three in a sport World Championship or World Cup competition.
- The person has served as a national team coach, guided athletes to achieve outstanding achievements in competitions and been able to help improve the sporting competitiveness of the ROC, and has achieved one of following accomplishments:
- finishing in the top eight in an official sport at the Olympic (1)Games.
- (2) finishing in the top three in an official sport at the Asian Games.
- (3) finishing in the top three in an official sport at the World Games.
- finishing in the top three in an official sport at the Universiade. (4)
- (5) finishing in the top three in a sport World Championship or World Cup competition.
- 3. The person has served as a referee for an official sport at the Olympic Games, Asian Games, World Games or Universiade and has been able to help improve the sporting competitiveness of the ROC.
- 4. The person previously held or currently holds a position in the sports industry in a foreign country or in the ROC, has one or more recommendation letters issued by a national sports organization in the ROC which is fully qualified for official membership of an international sports association, by a professional sports league in the ROC, by the National Sports Training Center or by a university or tertiary college in the ROC, and the person has the potential to make a contribution to the sports industry of the ROC.
