The person has served as an athlete in a national team, has outstanding skills and been able to help improve the sporting competitiveness of the ROC, and has achieved one of the following accomplishments:</p> <p>(1) finishing in the top eight in an official sport at the Olympic Games.</p> <p>(2) finishing in the top three in an official sport at the Asian Games.</p> <p>(3) finishing in the top three in an official sport at the World Games.</p> <p>(4) finishing in the top three in an official sport at the Universiade.</p> <p>(5) finishing in the top three in a sport World Championship or World Cup competition.</p> <p>2. The person has served as a national team coach, guided athletes to achieve outstanding achievements in competitions and been able to help improve the sporting competitiveness of the ROC, and has achieved one of following accomplishments:</p> <p>(1) finishing in the top eight in an official sport at the Olympic Games.</p> <p>(2) finishing in the top three in an official sport at the Asian Games.</p> <p>(3) finishing in the top three in an official sport at the World Games.</p> <p>(4) finishing in the top three in an official sport at the Universiade.</p> <p>(5) finishing in the top three in a sport World Championship or World Cup competition.</p> <p>3. The person has served as a referee for an official sport at the Olympic Games, Asian Games, World Games or Universiade and has been able to help improve the sporting competitiveness of the ROC.</p> <p>4. The person previously held or currently holds a position in the sports industry in a foreign country or in the ROC, has one or more recommendation letters issued by a national sports organization in the ROC which is fully qualified for official membership of an international sports association, by a professional sports league in the ROC, by the National Sports Training Center or by a university or tertiary college in the ROC, and the person has the potential to make a contribution to the sports industry of the ROC.</p>
